The situation in Spain is not good

In Spain not all the prisons and centres have distance learning available. Just some of them have it and it usually depends on external associations, volunteers and NGOs who works to make the distance learning accesible.

Situation in Granada

For instance, in Granada there is distance learning available for interns thanks to a volunteer and a couple of interns themselves who worked together on the creation and manteinance of the elearning platform during their time in the institution.

Distance learning offline

There are some resources available from the government but the main obstacle is that the distance learning must be offline because there is no access to internet in the institutions for the interns.
